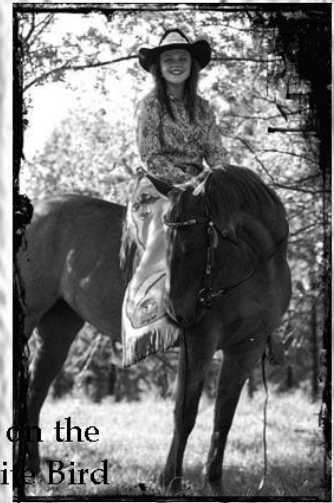


# WHITE BIRD RODEO QUEEN
